

Healthcare Hackathon Bayern – Terms and Conditions

Application and registration process

- This year, registration is a little different than at previous Healthcare Hackathons: If you would like to participate in the Healthcare Hackathon 2026, simply apply in advance via our application form. [Microsoft Forms](#)

Why all this? Our goal is to put together balanced teams and ensure that all areas of responsibility are well staffed. Your information helps us to carry out a fair and structured selection process.

Important: Submitting the application form does not yet constitute a binding registration and does not constitute a commitment to participate in the Healthcare Hackathon 2026. It is a selection process in which we review all applications and select them on the basis of the criteria mentioned. Only when you receive a registration confirmation by e-mail are you officially registered for the event.

If several applications fit equally well, the following applies: "First come, first served." The order in which applications are received can therefore be decisive.

You can apply until the end of September. As soon as we have reviewed your application, you will automatically receive an e-mail with a response. This will tell you whether your place has been confirmed or whether you are on the waiting list for the time being.

Prerequisites

- Hackers of all countries, genders and religions are welcome.
- There is no age limit for the hackathon.
- In the case of underage hackers, a written declaration of consent from a parent or guardian is required to participate in the hackathon.

- Members of the committee are excluded from participating in the hackathon. However, these participating teams are allowed to assist in the programming and development phase.
- There is no country restriction on participation, but taxes on Profits are incurred that must be borne and paid independently by the hackers.

Team

- Participation in the hackathon takes place on a "one team" basis; i.e., hackers can only participate in one team and cannot be members of multiple teams.
- If it is necessary for the successful processing of the challenge, we reserve the right to expand or reduce the teams before starting the hacking.

Challenges

- All hackers will work on a challenge during the Healthcare Hackathon Bavaria.
- The hackers will meet their challenge favorite on **26.11.2026** after the challenge pitches and discussions with the challenge giver. Whenever possible, they will work on their first choice. If this is not possible, they can choose another challenge.

Project Development

- All software development programs such as IDE, programming languages, etc. can be used. Cloud services are allowed to process non-personal data as long as the data does not leave the European Union.
- In order to ensure the competitive conditions for all hackers, the jury must be disclosed which part of the code has been developed on site and which part has already been worked on in advance. The use of open source frameworks and existing projects is allowed and desired.
- The results and codes of the project must be made available to the coaches or the jury or uploaded to the results server.

Travel expenses / reimbursement of travel expenses

- Travel expenses will not be reimbursed for the Healthcare Hackathon.

Intellectual Property / Use of Results

- All rights of use to the work results of the challenges are available to the challenge provider and the hacker team to the same extent. Neither the challenger nor the hackers may transfer or exploit the rights of use without the consent of the other.
- The rights of use to results that have already been developed in the run-up to the hackathon belong to the person who has developed them.
- All agreements that deviate from this general rule must be concluded directly between the team and the challenger.

Code of Conduct for Participants

Our hackathon is free of discrimination and harassment of any kind, especially with regard to origin, religion, age, gender, sexual orientation, disabilities, size, etc. We have no tolerance whatsoever for discrimination against participants in any form. Suggestive language is not appropriate during the hackathon, neither in the hacks, workshops, teamwork, parties or on social networks. Participants who violate these rules of conduct may be excluded from the competition by the organizers of the event.

Discrimination and harassment, for example through verbal comments on gender, gender identification, age, sexual orientation, disabilities, physical appearance, body size, religious affiliation, origin or threats, stalking, taking photos or filming without the consent of the person concerned, improper behaviour towards others, improper physical contact, are not permitted at the event. Otherwise, photography is desired and allowed.

We expect all attendees to follow this Code of Conduct throughout the event. Participants who violate the aforementioned rules may be excluded from further participation. The hacks created are also subject to the Anti-Discrimination Directive.

If you are discriminated against or harassed or notice this, we ask you to report this immediately to those responsible for the hackathon.

The hackathon organizing team is happy to help attendees in situations of discrimination and harassment to ensure a harassment-free event. We appreciate your participation!
